

Oral Communication Activities

The following activities may help with students' listening comprehension, oral production and conversational skills in French

Listening Comprehension Activities:

- Listen to and/or watch a French song, video, story, TV show, movie. Netflix offers French audio on some shows.
- You can follow up by asking your child to tell you something about what they've watched or listened to.

Oral Production Activities:

- Practice saying the months of the year, days of the week, the weather in French. Students are familiar with this as it is practiced daily at school. (Ex: Quel temps fait-il? Quelle est la date aujourd'hui...)
- Describing objects using French words. Example: colors of toys, describing family members hair and eye color.
- Saying whether they like or dislike various food in the cupboard/fridge, etc. (J'aime, je n'aime pas...).
- Students can do any of the activities above with the help of a puppet or toy.
- Record yourself saying French words and listen to it.
- Have a phone conversation with a relative or friend who speaks French.
